Houses a brewery at the rear of the bar on a mezzanine floor. Features a covered front terrace. 3 changing ales




### THE DEVONSHIRE TAP HOUSE

One of Harrogate's oldest pubs with a nationally important historic interior with gas lighting. 4 changing ales

### 6 Royal Parade HG1 2SZ

Showcasing this brewery's beers in the former 'Old Bell'. President Bill Clinton visited in 2001. 5 changing ales

#### Station Parade HG1 1TE

An impressive transformation of a neglected railway building into a fine pub. 12 changing ales

This Grade II listed pub has been a real ale destination in Ripon over many decades. 3 regular and 3 changing ales






### **CROSS KEYS**

### 36 Kirkgate HG4 1PB

This 18th Century coaching inn is Timothy Taylor's most northerly tied house.

2 regular and 2 changing ales | Closed Monday







### Platform 2, Knaresborough Station HG5 9AA
