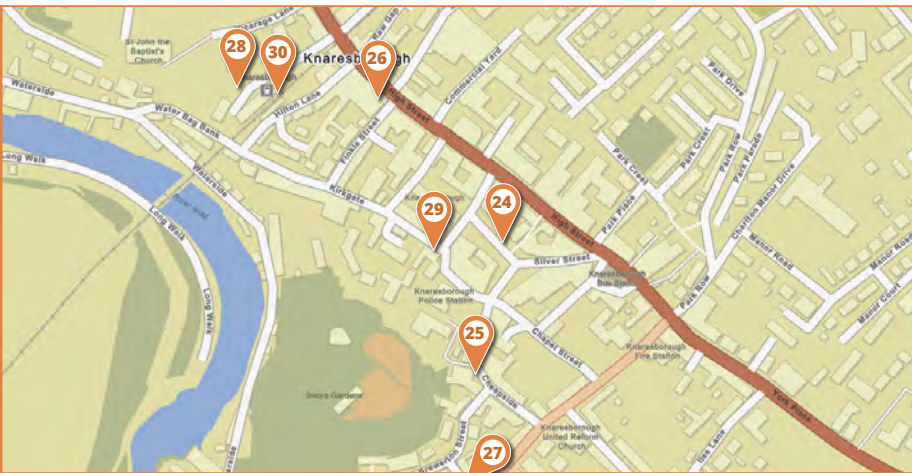

6 Royal Parade HG1 2SZ

6 Old Market Place HG4 1EQ

Greene King pub serving mostly Yorkshire ales. Number of sports screens.

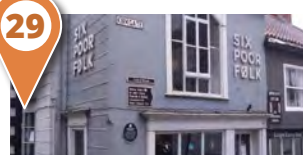
4 Station Road HG5 9AA
